



Husch holds a strong belief that wine should be affordable, especially within our local community. For this reason, we blend each year a white table wine that can be enjoyed by our friends and neighbors on a daily basis. We aim for this wine to be a local favorite, and it is only available in Mendocino County.

This wine is always a blend and it is always fun to craft each vintage. We have no set rules on varietal percentages and no standard recipe as to how the wine must be made. For these reasons, each vintage brings a slightly different wine yet it is always quaffable and quite affordable. The 2006 is a blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay, with a touch of Muscat Canelli and Gewurztraminer.

The wine shows a veritable medley of bright fruit aromas including mandarin orange, Meyer lemon, grapefruit, white peach, pear and Red Delicious apple. Floral notes of citrus blossom and honeysuckle round out the nose. The palate is crisp and clean and shows very well with lighter fare, including grilled seafood, lemon chicken, fresh fruit and cheese and Asian dishes.
