



2025 Gewurztraminer Juice

Anderson Valley, Mendocino County



History

Our grandmother Beatrice Oswald enjoyed the sweeter things in life, and she convinced our grandfather to begin crafting non-alcoholic juice in the early 1980s. Having grown up with these juices on our table, we are thrilled to continue the tradition of homemade varietal grape juice to share with our children, and yours!

Winemaking

This juice is made from 100% Anderson Valley Gewurztraminer grapes fresh from our estate vineyard. Picked at the perfect sweetness, the grapes were crushed, pressed, and the juice was bottled a week later. We do this before starting any winemaking fermentations, preventing yeast from entering the bottle. This juice is unpasteurized which preserves the aromatics and flavor profile.

Tasting Notes

Fresh and zippy, this grape juice leaps from the glass with aromas of tangerine, rosehip, honeycomb, and lychee. Layers of expressive fruit are balanced by a subtle thread of ginger spice, carrying through to a long, satisfying finish. The 2025 Gewurztraminer juice is a standout—aromatic, lively, and made to be savored on any occasion and by all ages.
